• Classification, Dues and Assessments

New International Market Member: A company meeting the qualifications of the Rubber Producer or Rubber User Classification located in an area where Asphalt-Rubber is not routinely used or specified.
\$2000 Annual Membership fee *+

RPA bylaws require that each new international market member shall submit monthly reports on the sale or purchase of crumb rubber used in asphalt applications. **

* "New International Market Members" are exempt from assessments for three years provided rubber sales or consumption or applications does not occur in routine use markets where a standard specification has been used for 5 years or more

"New International Market Members" following the completion of three years in compliance with the assessment exemption policy, the assessments shall be 25% of that of the "User" and "Producer" members that do not qualify as New International Market Members.

Currently, "User" members (contractors/blenders) shall remit an assessment of \$0.005 per each pound of crumb rubber used in asphalt applications up to \$36,000.00/year. If the cap is met during the year there are no further assessments to be made. "Producer" members shall remit an assessment of \$0.005 per each pound of crumb rubber sold into asphalt applications up to \$30,000.00/year.

+Eligible to serve on the Association Board of Directors after a 2.5 million pound qualification in usage or production of crumb rubber assessments paid into the association prior to BOD voting eligibility.

**Asphalt applications include: Wet Process, Dry Process, Terminal Blends, and Rubberized Slurry Seals.

Applications for membership will not be presented to the Board of Directors unless a check for dues in United States Dollars is included.
